

"Torrian Official" (T.O.), was born Torrian Dedmon, 1988. Southern California Native, second of three children. His story is deep and just as passionate as the music he introduces to the world. His musical influence comes from his mother singing in church, and his father's lyrical cadence as a rapper. Unfortunately his parents separated when T.O. was a young 13 years old. Torrian began running away from home and participating in gang activity with his grades going from a 4.0 GPA, to barely attending school while taking on the dangerous lifestyle of the streets, sleeping in cars, laundry mats, and wherever he could lay his head. In 2009, Torrian was sentenced to two years in prison and while incarcerated, he polished up his writing skills and completed several ballads. A song T.O. feels most connected to he titled "A Woman's Worth". He started writing this song during his senior year of high school, but wasn't able to complete it until he was incarcerated. The song is a tribute to all women. The inspiration came to Torrian after witnessing his close friend's mother being a victim of domestic violence.



Upon release from prison Torrian enrolled in a barbering school and completed his school to obtain his barbering license. But with a passion to succeed in the music industry, Torrian's ambition drove him to achieve an opportunity to perform on 106 & Park's "Wild Out Wednesday", to performing on the same stage as Jagged Edge, and Ray J just to name a few. In addition, Torrian has performed for his community on several occasions for various events such as "Peace in These Streets", "Kumba Fest", and "Pro Players Christmas Giveaway" among others. Torrian Official aims to use the hardships and struggles he has been through to not only share musically with the world, but he also aims to give back by helping children stay on the right path. Torrian has volunteered at the YMCA, local high schools as a basketball coach, the Boys and Girls Club, as well as for an organization known as the TKF Foundation. One of T.O.'s goal's is to pursue a high school music tour sharing his music and inspiring the youth to accomplish their dreams. With diverse musical influences such as Marvin Gaye, Boys II Men, Usher, Stevie Wonder, Whitney Houston, Tank and Chris Brown, it is clear why Torrian's approach to R&B music is so vibrant and refreshing. He soothes his audience with songs like "Starts with me", a commitment to fatherhood and an ode to his daughters. Torrian's novel combination provides an appealing contrast that he wants people to relate to.




